We are exceptionally proud of our multi-cultural, multi-faith school community. Students from all backgrounds are welcomed, different cultures and religions are celebrated, all with an ethos of mutual respect and tolerance.

We hold weekly assemblies to discuss social, moral and religious issues. Opportunities are provided for students to pray or reflect as appropriate. Religious festivals such as Christmas, Eid, Diwali and Guru Nanak are also referenced and celebrated. RE is taught discretely in Years 8 and 9 and is offered as an option in Year 10. This is reinforced within the PHSE curriculum in Year 7 and Years 10 and 11.

Opportunities are provided for students to follow their religious beliefs whilst at school. We have held multi-faith celebrations and held awareness raising sessions to develop understanding and respect for others beliefs and cultures.
