At Leytonstone School we provide our students with a broad and balanced curriculum so that all our students achieve to their potential. We are currently reviewing our curriculum to ensure the needs of all our students are met. This review will be completed by the end of the 2014/15 academic year. Parents will be informed about any changes that are made.

We follow the National Curriculum, with a combination of compulsory and additional options at GCSE. Subject specific information is available on our web site. In Key Stage 3 there is extra support in numeracy and literacy for students who find it difficult to access the curriculum. We have an active More Able and Talented group who are stretched and challenged both in lessons and through extra-curricular activities and events.

In KS4 students are encouraged to follow an academic curriculum to provide access to the Russell Group of Universities. We believe equally that the Arts, Sports and Technology subjects have an important contribution to make to our students education and again a wide variety of extra curricula opportunities exist for our students in these subjects. In addition we run a PHSE programme to ensure our students are aware of current issues that may affect them and how they can stay safe.
