SPRING TERM 2020 – INSTRUMENTAL AND SINGING LESSONS

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share with you some of the musical opportunities available to your child at Leytonstone. As part of the music department's extra-curricular programme, instrumental and vocal lessons for students are available and are organised through Waltham Forest Music Service. Last academic year there were over 70 students in the school taking individual instrumental or singing lessons and I would strongly encourage you to make most of this opportunity.

Important information:

1. **LESSON TIMES**: All individual lessons are 20 or 40 minutes. Please be aware that the timetable is the consequence of the availability of the instrumental teachers and therefore, some lessons might happen during lunch break or after school. The school is subsidising these lesson for all pupils and the subsidy levels are listed below. Tuition costs for 10 lessons (term) at subsidised costs are as follows:

Individual Lesson – 20 minutes (Subsidised 15%)	123.30
Individual Lesson – 40 minutes (Subsidised 15%)	246.60
Pupils on Free School Meals - 20 minutes (Subsidised 50%)	72.50
Pupils on Free School Meals - 40 minutes (Subsidised 50%)	145.00

FEES: Fees are not refundable. You must pay for the lessons by 22nd November 2020 to ensure confirmation of booking. The payment instruction for these lessons will be on Parent Pay between 16th and 22nd November 2020.

- 2. ATTENDANCE: It is a student's responsibility to check the notice board outside the music office to confirm their lesson time as timings might change. In the case of a peripatetic teacher being absent, students will receive a credit towards a replacement lesson during the same term.
- 3. **INSURANCE:** It is a parent's/carer's responsibility to insure a student's instrument. The school is not responsible for damage, theft or repair of instruments. Students leave instruments in school at their own risk. This applies to privately owned instruments or a private instrumental rental scheme through Music Service.
- 4. **SAFETY DURING COVID19:** To ensure pupil's safety during this uncertain times, we have put safety measures in place as follows:
 - a. Instrumental teacher and pupil must be at least 2m away from each other throughout the duration of a lesson (even during demonstrations)
 - b. Apart from woodwind and brass instruments, instruments can be shared (drums, keyboard/piano, guitar) but cleaning with disinfected wipes must be ensured by instrumental teacher after each pupil
 - c. Pupils can only use their own woodwind and brass instruments and must not share them
 - d. During 40 minutes' lessons, doors must stay open at all times to ensure ventilation
- 5. **CANCELLING:** Your child is going to be automatically re-enrolled into next term, unless you notify myself in writing or via e-mail (<u>tstimec.320@lgflmail.org</u>) that you wish to cancel their lessons. You can cancel lessons by the last day before the half herm (14.02.2021 or 15.05.2021)
