I am writing to you about some important changes for Year 10 starting on the 10th of May.

In order to support Year 10 with their transition into Year 11 we have decided to move their assembly/form time back to the original start time of 8.40am with the end of the school day coming at 3.00pm.

This move will support pupils by enabling them to participate in our new intervention programme called 'Study Hall'.

Study Hall will take place after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:10-4:30pm in the Main Hall.

Tuesdays will be dedicated to Science and option subjects and Thursdays will be focused on English and Maths.

Pupils will have the opportunity to revise, work on past papers or complete work in these specific subjects. Teachers from those subjects will be present to answer questions and provide support.

Students will be able to sign up for these sessions on Monday mornings during form time.

Please encourage your child to take advantage of these interventions. Along with hard work during curriculum time, we believe it will bring about excellent outcomes for each pupil next year.
