Re: GCSE results day 2021

Dear families,

This year's GCSE results day will take place **Thursday 12th August**. We understand and recognise that although the awarding of GCSE grades was unlike a 'normal' year due to the global pandemic, it doesn't make this day any less significant. The grades that will be awarded this summer will look exactly the same as in previous years, and will have equal status with colleges, universities and future employers.

Pupils will be invited in to the school to collect their results in person during the time slot indicated:

At results day, support will be available from the Careers Lead to discuss possible routes and options for further education should they wish to take advantage.

All students will be required to provide a signature in order to collect their results. If pupils wish any other person (including family members) to collect results on their behalf, written consent must be provided and brought with them, along with photo ID, in order for results to be handed over.

Candidates who do not collect their results at this session will receive their results by 1st class post.

Results will not be given out by telephone under any circumstances.

GCSE certificates will be available from the school reception from December 2021, and will need to be signed for on collection. Please note that GCSE certificates are kept by the school for a maximum of one year, after which they are sent back to the exam boards. Retrieving certificates from exam boards can be expensive and difficult; you are therefore urged to collect your certificates as soon as possible and to keep them safe.

We look forward to welcoming our leavers back with us for results day 2021, and wish each of them the best luck on their future journey.
