Leyton Cricket Ground does have an indoor pavilion which we will make available for any pupils who are struggling with the heat.

The Plan - Years 7 and 8

- Arrive at school for 8am sharp for registration.

- Pupils will participate in track events only, plus a tug of war contest.
- Pupils will be walked back to school. Expected arrival for 11am.
- Pupils have their break and then take part in some indoor sports-themed activities with their tutors.

- Pupils who wish to collect a packed lunch will be able to do so from the canteen.
