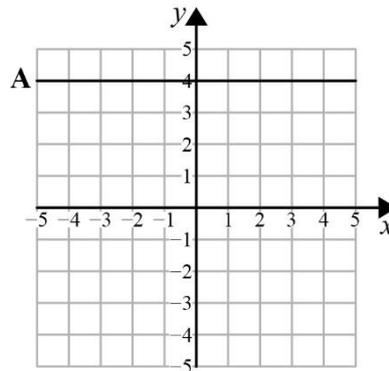

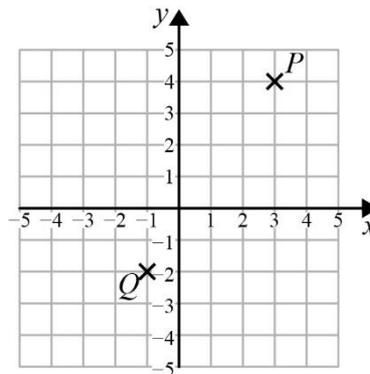
a Write down the equation of the line marked A.

$M$  is the midpoint of the line  $PQ$ .

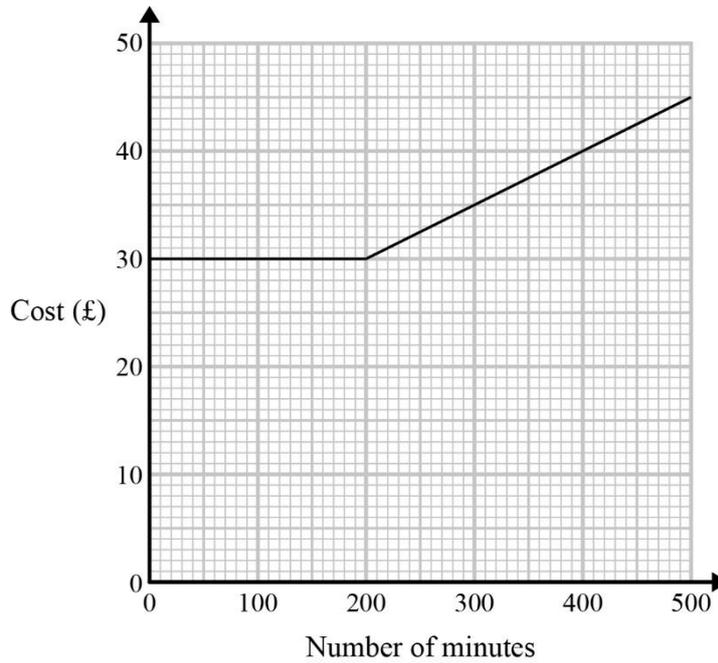
b On the grid, mark with a cross (x) the point  $M$ .

- 5 The graph shows the cost of using a mobile phone for one month for numbers of minutes of calls made.



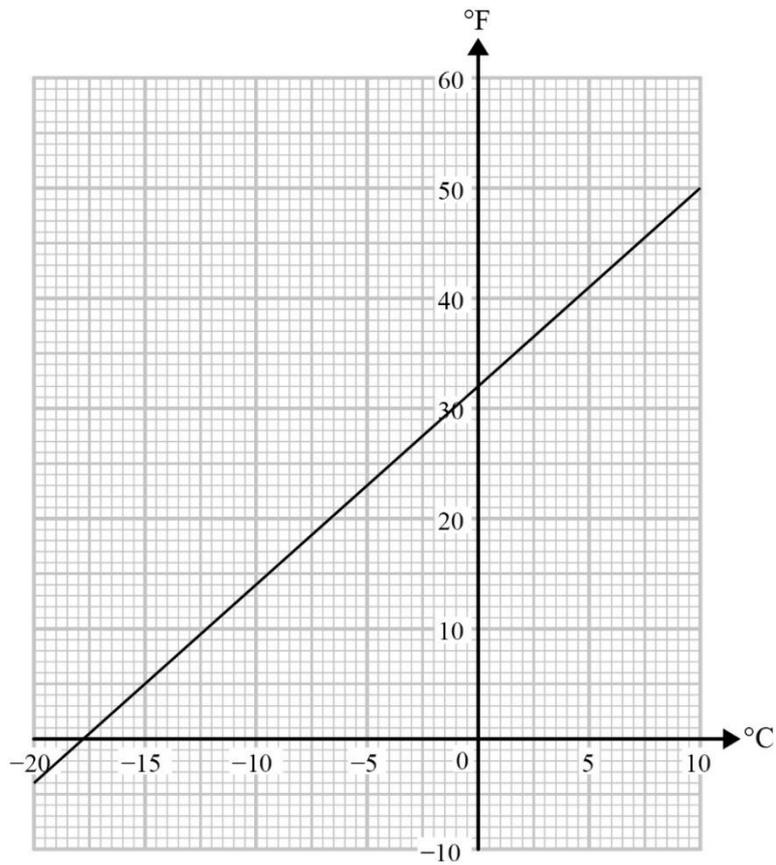
The cost includes a fixed contract charge of £30 and a charge for each minute made over the contract allowance.

The temperature recorded at midnight in town A is  $-15^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

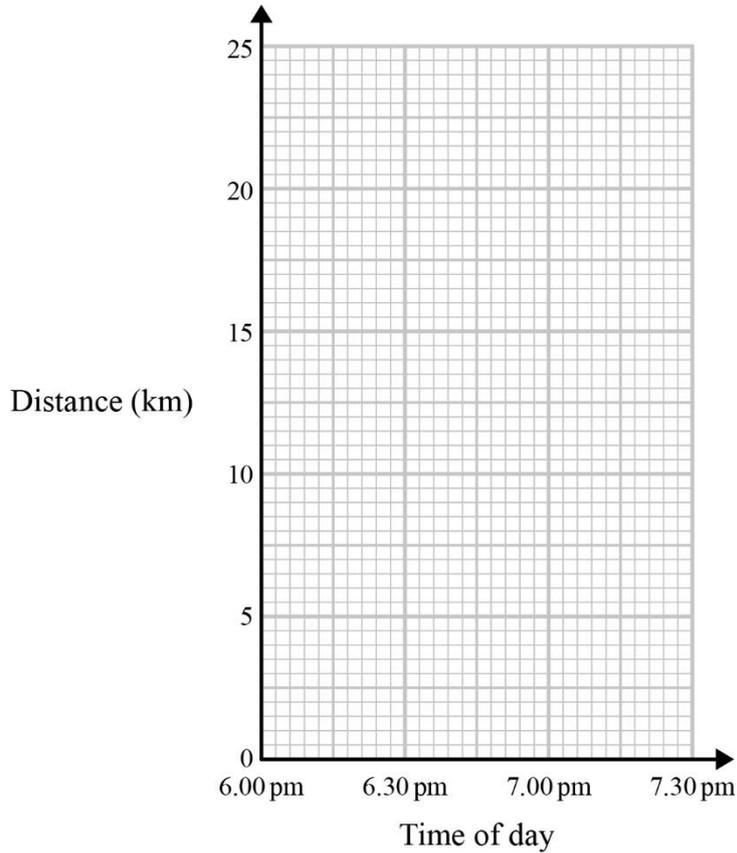
The temperature in town B is  $0^{\circ}\text{F}$ .

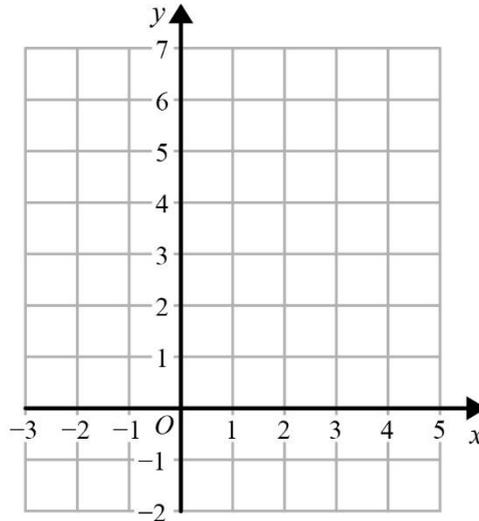
From 7.15 pm to 7.30 pm Jamie cycled at an average speed of 12 km/h.

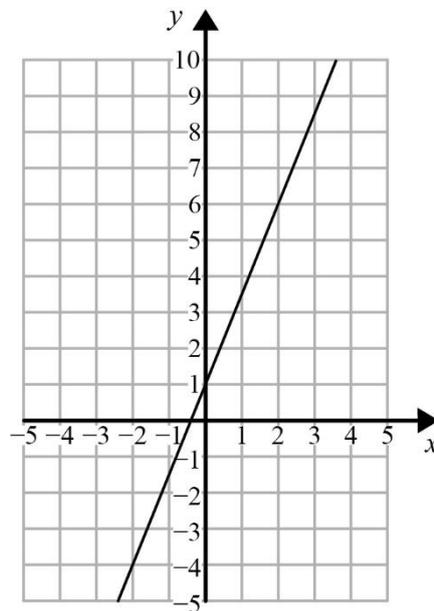


11 On the grid, draw the graph of  $y = \frac{1}{2}x + 1$  for values of  $x$  from  $-2$  to  $4$ .

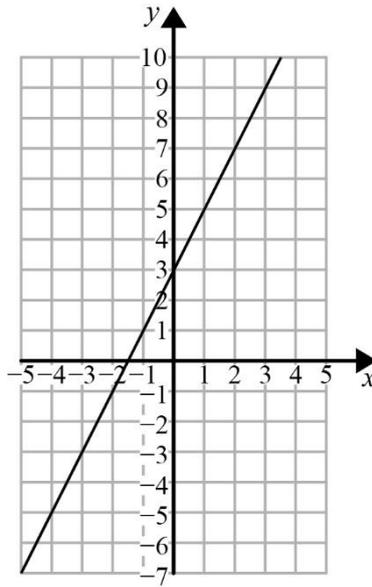
13 Find the gradient of the straight line drawn on this grid.
