Re: Year 11 Partnership Evening and Intervention

Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you about the different interventions that will take place for our Year 11's this year. Our vision is to empower this year group to overcome the difficulties that they have experienced this year and be able to leave Leytonstone with results they can be proud of.

Our interventions aim to enable the students to take responsibility for their learning but at the same time give them the support that they missed during the lockdown. Firstly, in order to create good habits and start the day off well. Students will be expected to use Form time on Wednesday and Fridays to do some quiet study. This can be reading through classwork, writing flash cards or other. Heads of Departments will also be providing videos giving specific advice for their subject.

The second intervention is called Study Hall. This will take place after school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3:10-4:30pm in the Main Hall. Tuesdays will be Science and Option subjects and Wednesday will be English and Maths. Students will be given the opportunity to revise, work on past papers or complete work in the specific subjects. Teachers from those subjects will be there to answer questions or give support the students. Students can sign up for these sessions on Monday mornings.

Finally, we have revision blocks where all students will be asked to revise at home each day after school for a 2 week period in a particular subject. Students work will be checked to ensure that it is being completed. These revision blocks will take place in November, before mocks in February and in March.

We are really excited about taking on the challenge ahead of us and have already seen a positive response to Study Hall that started this week. Please encourage your student to take advantage of these interventions and along with hard work in curriculum time, we believe it will bring excellent outcomes to each student next year.

On Wednesday 23rd September there will be a virtual Year 11 Partnership Evening from 5-6pm on Zoom where you will be able to get more information about the upcoming year. Details are overleaf.
